An Act to provide for making supplementary provision to meet additional expenditure for the financial year 1st April 2004 to 31st March 2005 (both dates inclusive).

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Supply (FY 2004) Act 2005.

5 2.—(1) A further sum of \$1,572,432,070, not otherwise provided for by the Supply Act 2004 (Act 8 of 2004), is hereby authorised to be issued from the Consolidated Fund for the period from 1st April 2004 to 31st March 2005 (both dates inclusive).

10 (2) The sum specified in subsection (1) is hereby appropriated for the purposes of the Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

In accordance with Articles 148(2) and 148C(2) of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, this Bill seeks to make additional provision for the financial year 1st April 2004 to 31st March 2005 (both dates inclusive) to meet expenditure in excess of the sums authorised by the Supply Act 2004 (Act 8 of 2004). Supplementary estimates in respect of the additional provisions have been laid before Parliament.
