

Yao Quan is CEO of Quantedge Foundation, a philanthropic organisation that focuses on strengthening social mobility and expanding opportunities for disadvantaged communities in Singapore. He was previously Head of Healthcare Redesign at Alexandra Hospital, where he worked on meeting the healthcare needs of Singaporeans and led the hospital's COVID-19 operations.

Before moving into public healthcare, Yao Quan spent five years in the private sector with an investment company. He earlier spent six years in the SAF.

Yao Quan serves the community in various other capacities.
