**OFFICIAL VISIT OF SPEAKER SEAH KIAN PENG
TO PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA (PRC) - XIAMEN, FUZHOU AND BEIJING
FROM 8 TO 13 June 2026**

The Speaker of the Parliament of Singapore, Mr Seah Kian Peng, is on an Official Visit to the People's Republic of China (PRC) from 8 to 13 June 2026 at the invitation of His Excellency Zhao Leji, Chairman of the Standing Committee of the National People's Congress of the PRC. Speaker Seah will visit Xiamen, Fuzhou, and Beijing. This is his first visit to the PRC in his capacity as Speaker.

2 Speaker Seah will be accompanied by a delegation comprising Members of Parliament: Mr Liang Eng Hwa, Ms Sylvia Lim, Ms Poh Li San, Dr Wan Rizal, Ms Elysa Chen, and Mr Sanjeev Kumar Tiwari.

3 In Xiamen, Speaker Seah and the MPs will meet Chairman of the Standing Committee of Xiamen Municipal People's Congress Yang Guohao. The delegation will visit PSA and ST Engineering facilities in Xiamen and engage Chinese companies. Speaker Seah will also attend a reception with Overseas Singaporeans, reinforcing the strong people-to-people ties between Singapore and the PRC.

4 The delegation will proceed to Fuzhou, where Speaker Seah and the MPs will meet Secretary of the Fujian Provincial Committee of the Communist Party of China (CPC) Zhou Zuyi. Other engagements include visits to local Chinese companies to foster economic cooperation and explore avenues for enhanced collaboration.

5 In Beijing, Speaker Seah and the delegation will meet and be hosted to dinner by Chairman of the Standing Committee of the National People's Congress Zhao Leji. Speaker Seah will also have bilateral meetings with PRC Vice President Han Zheng and Minister of the International Department of the CPC Central Committee Liu Haixing. These engagements reaffirm the strong and friendly bilateral ties between

Singapore and China and provide valuable opportunities for parliamentary and people-to-people exchanges.
