A BILL

intituled

An Act to amend the Criminal Law (Temporary Provisions) Act
(Chapter 67 of the 2000 Revised Edition).

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the
Parliament of Singapore, as follows:

Short title and commencement

1. This Act may be cited as the Criminal Law (Temporary Provisions) (Amendment) Act 2009 and shall come into operation on 21st October 2009.

5 **Amendment of section 1**

2. Section 1 of the Criminal Law (Temporary Provisions) Act is amended by deleting subsection (2) and substituting the following subsection:

10 “(2) This Act shall continue in force for a period of 5 years from 21st October 2009.”.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This Bill seeks to amend the Criminal Law (Temporary Provisions) Act (Cap. 67).

Clause 1 relates to the short title and commencement.

Clause 2 amends section 1(2) to extend the operation of the Act for a further period of 5 years from 21st October 2009.

EXPENDITURE OF PUBLIC MONEY

This Bill will not involve the Government in any extra financial expenditure.
