- Present case studies of individual services or laws where parliamentary libraries and research services have made a contribution
- Consider cross national issues, for example, knowledge sharing and research about laws and lawmaking on similar topics in different countries and at supra-national and regional levels
- Look at the role of technology and open data in comparative study of legislation
- Consider public outreach by parliamentary libraries and research services to help inform the wider legislative process
