

GAN THIAM POH 颜添宝

Member of Parliament, Ang Mo Kio GRC

Mr Gan Thiam Poh is the Member of Parliament for Ang Mo Kio GRC. He is an Adviser of Ang Mo Kio GRC Grassroots Organisations and a Member of the Ang Mo Kio Town Council. In addition, he serves as an Adviser to the Singapore Maritime Officers' Union, the Building Construction and Timber Industries Employees' Union and the Singapore Basketball Association.

For his contributions to the Labour Movement, he was given the Friend of Labour Award during the NTUC May Day Awards 2019.

He first became a Member of Parliament in 2011 representing Pasir Ris-Punggol GRC. During that period (2011-2015), he held the positions of Deputy Chairman of the Regional Parliamentary Group, Internal Auditor of the Singapore Parliamentary Society, Member of the Government Parliamentary Committees (GPCs) for Transport, National Development and Water Resources, Vice-Chairman of Pasir Ris-Punggol Town Council and Adviser to the Pasir Ris-Punggol GRC Grassroots Organisations.

He was also Member of the Singapore Parliamentary Committee – Public Accounts Committee (2013-2015), Member of SME Workgroup (Ministry of Trade and Finance) (2013-2015).

In 2015, he was re-elected to represent Ang Mo Kio GRC. He was appointed to serve as the Vice-Chair of the Government Parliamentary Committee for the Environment and Water Resources, and Member of the GPCs for National Development during that term of office.

Mr Gan has worked at DBS Bank since 2002 and is currently its Senior Vice President of DBS Private Banking. Prior to DBS, he had held senior and leadership roles at foreign and local bank.

He graduated from the National University of Singapore with a Bachelor of Science degree in Economics, Mathematics and Computer Applications and Programming in 1988. He obtained his Diploma (Distinction) in Costing with credits in Accounting and Statistics from the London Chamber of Commerce and Industry in 1983. In 2003, he attained a Certificate of Interpretation and Translation (English/Chinese) from Temasek Polytechnic.
