QUESTIONS FOR ORAL ANSWER

- *1. Madam Chan Choy Siong: To ask the Minister for Education when will Government secondary schools be built in the Bukit Ho Swee area.
 - *2. Mr. Ng Kah Ting: To ask the Minister for National Development whether and when a Veterinary Centre will be built in the Punggol Constituency.
 - *3. Mr. Ng Kah Ting: To ask the Minister for National Development whether and when electricity will be supplied from 9 milestone Punggol Road to Punggol Point.
 - *4. Mr. Tan Cheng Tong: To ask the Minister for National Development when will electricity be supplied to the areas around 11 milestone Yio Chu Kang Road.
 - *5. Mr. Ng Kah Ting: To ask the Minister for National Development when will Lorong Buang Kok, which is a link to Yio Chu Kang Road, be widened and metalled.
 - *6. Mr. Tan Cheng Tong: To ask the Minister for National Development when will the following unmetalled agricultural roads be repaired: (a) two of the four roads linking Boh Sua Tian Road at 9½ milestone Yio Chu Kang Road to Sungei Seletar Fishing Village; (b) Track 23 between 9½ milestone Yio Chu Kang Road and Cheng San Road; (c) upper Tong Lee Road between Jalan Kayu and Boh Sua Tian Road; and (d) Track 22 at 11 milestone Yio Chu Kang Road.
 - *7. Mr. Tan Cheng Tong: To ask the Minister for National Development whether the Government has any plan to build in the rural areas more bus-stop shelters at places where there are no shops or houses.
 - *8. Mr. Ong Lian Teng: To ask the Minister for National Development how many families were affected adversely by the building of a Home for the Aged in Woodlands and how many of these families did not receive compensation from the Government.
 - *9. Madam Chan Choy Siong: To ask the Minister for National Development whether and when children's playgrounds are to be provided in Bukit Ho Swee Estate and other Housing Board Estates.
 - *10. Mr. Ong Lian Teng: To ask the Minister for Social Affairs between 1st June, 1964, and 30th September, 1964, (a) how many of the people who were in receipt of public assistance had had their assistance stopped; (b) how many had had their assistance reduced; and (c) what was the total amount involved in each case.
