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#### QUESTIONS FOR ORAL ANSWER

- \*1. **Mr. P. Govindaswamy:** To ask the Minister for Foreign Affairs and Minister for Labour how many applications for Singapore citizenship from male applicants, whose respective wives and families are Singapore citizens, have been approved since May, 1968.
- \*2. **Mr. P. Govindaswamy:** To ask the Minister for Foreign Affairs and Minister for Labour how many work permits have been issued since May, 1968 (i) to blue identity card holders; and (ii) to others.
- \*3. **Mr. N. Govindasamy:** To ask the Minister for Education (a) how many teachers have attended in-service training courses, which will qualify them for incremental credits, up to the latest convenient date; (b) what is the basis of selection of teachers for participation in such courses; (c) how many teachers have attended more than one such course; (d) how many teachers who had undergone in-service training courses have been utilised in the Education Service; and (e) whether he will consider increasing the number of in-service training courses to enable more teachers to take advantage of such courses.
- \*4. **Mr. N. Govindasamy:** To ask the Minister for Education whether he is aware of any brain drain from the Republic as a result of persons going abroad for further education or specialised training and failing to return to Singapore on completion of their courses; and if he will consider taking steps to minimise this brain drain.
- \*5. **Mr. Ng Kah Ting:** To ask the Minister for Communications whether he will consider setting up a committee to review the public transport system in the Republic; to assess public needs in the next five years, and to make recommendations.
- \*6. **Mr. Ng Kah Ting:** To ask the Minister for Communications (a) whether the present facilities at the Paya Lebar International Airport are sufficient to cope with the anticipated increase in air traffic in the 1970s; and (b) whether there are any plans to meet the anticipated increase in passenger traffic with the introduction of the Jumbo Jets.

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- \*7. Enche Abdul Aziz Karim:** To ask the Minister for Defence if he will permit an infant born outside Singapore to enter and reside permanently in the Republic if either of his parents is a Singapore citizen and is permanently residing in Singapore.
- \*8. Mr. Tay Boon Too:** To ask the Minister for Law and National Development (a) how many residents along Upper Paya Lebar Road are affected by the widening of the road; (b) whether any compensation has been paid to those residents; and (c) what plans have been made to resettle them.
- \*9. Mr. Tay Boon Too:** To ask the Minister for Law and National Development (a) how many residents along Airport Road have applied for permission to have entrances from the Road to their houses for vehicles; (b) how many of those applications have been (i) allowed; and (ii) rejected, and the reasons for the rejections; and (c) why have the authorities of Hong San School been refused permission to have an entrance at Airport Road for the convenience of the pupils.
- \*10. Mr. P. Selvadurai:** To ask the Minister for Law and National Development if he will consider extending the benefits of modern sanitation throughout the Republic.
- \*11. Enche Abdul Aziz Karim:** To ask the Minister for Law and National Development (a) if he will request the Housing and Development Board to allocate flats or shophouses, according to choice, to the residents of the Bajera Lane and Towner Road areas who are affected by clearance action; and (b) if he will give an assurance that the Public Works Department and the Letting Section of the Housing and Development Board will co-ordinate their activities in the clearance of those areas so as to avoid any embarrassment or inconvenience to all parties concerned.
- \*12. Enche Abdul Aziz Karim:** To ask the Minister for Health if he will consider (i) attaching a full-time Medical Officer to the Industrial Health Unit; and (ii) expanding the Unit and increasing its functional activities.
