QUESTIONS FOR ORAL ANSWER

- *1. **Enche Abdul Aziz Karim:** To ask the Minister for Finance what is the total amount of payroll tax that has been collected since the tax was introduced up to the latest convenient date; and whether the moneys collected in the form of payroll tax will be used to introduce a social insurance scheme to fulfil the Government's promise to the working people of Singapore.
- *2. **Mr. Tay Boon Too:** To ask the Minister for Education (a) the number of teachers whose services were terminated from 1969 up to the latest convenient date, and on what grounds; (b) the number of teachers who left the service voluntarily, and the reasons for their leaving; (c) how many of the teachers whose services were terminated were (i) trained, and (ii) untrained teachers; and (d) how many of the teachers who left voluntarily were (i) trained, and (ii) untrained teachers.
- *3. **Mr. Tay Boon Too:** To ask the Minister for Law and National Development if he will ascertain from the Housing and Development Board what was the cost of building the former market in Jalan Pipit, and why that market was demolished late last year; and what are the reasons for rebuilding another market on the same site, and how much it will cost.
- *4. **Mr. Tay Boon Too:** To ask the Minister for Law and National Development whether and what development plans the Government has for the Paya Lebar Constituency, especially the area bounded by Airport Road, Kim Chuan Road and Upper Paya Lebar Road.
