- *1. Mr. Ho Kah Leong: To ask the Minister for Education (a) how many schools have been built since 1959; (b) are all those schools provided with adequate sports grounds; and (c) in how many of those schools have the ground floors cracked; what are the reasons for the cracks; and has any remedial action been taken.
