OUESTIONS FOR ORAL ANSWER

- *1. Enche Rahmat bin Kenap: To ask the Minister for Finance, in view of the Government's policy to build a rugged and robust society, if he will consider standardizing the normal working hours of civil servants to the hours from 8 a.m. to 4.30 p.m., so as to allow all civil servants more time in the evenings to partake in the various forms of exercise.
- *2. Mr. Ch'ng Jit Koon: To ask the Minister for Education whether there is any insurance coverage against physical injury resulting from accidents for workshop instructors and students in industrial training centres and vocational institutes doing practical subjects.
- *3. Enche Rahmat bin Kenap: To ask the Minister for Defence if a survey has been made by the Police as to whether timber lorries using busy roads, like Nicoll Highway, in and near the City centre during peak periods are a cause of traffic congestion and a possible hazard to other road users; and whether and what remedial action will be taken.
- *4. Mr. Ch'ng Jit Koon: To ask the Minister for Social Affairs whether hawkers are eligible for public assistance allowance and, if not, why.
