## QUESTIONS FOR ORAL ANSWER

- \*1. Mr. J. F. Conceicao: To ask the Minister for Communications what progress has been made in the consideration given to the need for a mass rapid transit system for Singapore.
- \*2. Mr. Teong Eng Siong: To ask the Minister for Law and National Development (a) if immediate steps will be taken to repair Jalan Ulu Sembawang which is badly damaged; and (b) when work will commence (i) to repair Lorong Kasemek; and (ii) to install street lights at Chong Sin Road near the Huang Long Community Centre.
- \*3. Mr. Ch'ng Jit Koon: To ask the Minister for Law and National Development when work will commence on the construction of the proposed new bus bay at Tiong Bahru Road between Seng Poh Road and Jalan Membina.
- \*4. Mr. Ang Nam Piau: To ask the Minister for Law and National Development if Sin Min Public School will be affected by developments in the Sin Min Road area, and whether and when an alternative site will be provided for the School.
- \*5. Mr. Hwang Soo Jin: To ask the Minister for Finance if he is now in a position to publish the findings of the Research Division of his Ministry into the activities of chit fund companies, and whether he now feels that the subject merits legislation and, if not, why not.
- \*6. Mr. J. F. Conceicao: To ask the Minister for Home Affairs what was the frequency of road accidents involving drunken drivers, and the number of those injured and killed in such accidents, for the year ending 31st January, 1971.
- \*7. Mr. J. F. Conceicao: To ask the Minister for Home Affairs what was the frequency of traffic accidents involving pedestrians within 100 yards of a pedestrian crossing or overhead bridge, and the number of those seriously injured or killed in such accidents for the year ending 31st January, 1971.
