- *1. **Mr. Hwang Soo Jin:** To ask the Minister for Finance whether it was not possible to reconcile the conflicting objectives of the Singapore and Malaysian Governments on the running of MSA, chiefly in relation to the expansion of Malaysian domestic air services, in order to avoid a dissolution of their partnership. Next, what is the current state of the negotiations and what are the objectives of the proposed Singapore national airline.
