● **YANG DI-PERTUAN NEGARA'S SPEECH (ADDRESS OF THANKS):**

Motion made by the Prime Minister and Question proposed—

As an amendment to the motion, “at end, to add—

‘but (i) this Assembly regrets that the Government has not given any assurances in regard to any effective steps the Government has taken or will take in regard to kidnapping; (ii) this Assembly urges the Government to give to those civil servants who have resigned an opportunity to return to the Civil Service and other Government Services to make possible the construction of the various projects outlined in the speech’.”
