QUESTIONS FOR ORAL ANSWER

- *1. Mr. Hwang Soo Jin: To ask the Minister for Foreign Affairs and Labour the total number of applications for citizenship received (i) between 1st January and 31st December, 1967; and (ii) between 1st January and 30th April, 1968; and what measures have been or are being taken to speed up the processing of applications.
- *2. Mr. L. P. Rodrigo: To ask the Minister for Education whether investigations are conducted into allegations against teachers which are contained in anonymous letters addressed to him or to any official in his Ministry or brought to his Ministry's notice; and how many investigations of this kind were undertaken in 1967.
- *3. Mr. Ng Kah Ting: To ask the Minister for Law and National Development if he will ascertain from the Public Utilities Board whether the Board plans to expand its sub-collection centre at the Lim Tua Tow Road Market, which is inadequate, or to set up additional such centres in the surrounding areas.
- *4. Mr. Ng Kah Ting: To ask the Minister for Law and National Development whether he will consider reducing the Temporary Permit fees for temporary structures like chicken-coops and pig-sties from the present \$12 per annum to \$2 per annum.
