OFFICIAL VISIT OF SPEAKER OF PARLIAMENT TO KUALA LUMPUR, MALAYSIA, FROM 18 MARCH TO 20 MARCH 2019

Speaker of Parliament Mr Tan Chuan-Jin will make an Official Visit to Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, from 18 to 20 March 2019. This will be Mr Tan's inaugural Official Visit since being elected to the post of Speaker in September 2017. Mr Tan will be accompanied by Members of Parliament Mr Vikram Nair, Mr Pritam Singh, Mr Melvin Yong, Mr Yee Chia Hsing, Ms Joan Pereira, Mr Henry Kwek and Mr Saktiandi Supaat, and Nominated Member of Parliament Ms Anthea Ong.

- 2 Mr Tan and his delegation will be hosted by Yang Berhormat (YB) Dato' Mohamad Ariff Md Yusof, Speaker of the Dewan Rakyat (House of Representatives). On 19 March, they are scheduled to make courtesy calls on Dato' Ariff as well as YB Senator Tan Sri Dato' Sri S.A. Vigneswaran, President of the Dewan Negara (Senate) to exchange views and enhance parliamentary dialogue. The delegation will also observe a parliamentary sitting in the Dewan Rakyat and hold a meeting with Minister in the Prime Minister's Department (Legal and Parliamentary Affairs) YB Datuk Liew Vui Keong.
- Mr Tan will deliver a speech on governance from a parliamentary perspective on 19 March as he has been invited by Dato' Ariff to share his views for the Dewan Rakyat Speaker Lecture Series. While in Kuala Lumpur, Mr Tan and his delegation will also have the opportunity to meet and dialogue with various Malaysian parliamentarians with a view to broaden and deepen relations.
