

TAN WU MENG (陈有明)

Wu Meng has served as MP for Jurong GRC since 2015.

Wu Meng has been a medical doctor for many years. He specialises in oncology, looking after cancer patients. He trained and served at the National Cancer Centre Singapore and Singapore General Hospital, and has worked in public and private sector healthcare.

He served as Senior Parliamentary Secretary in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA) and the Ministry of Trade and Industry (MTI) from 2018 to 2020. He spoke up for Singapore's interests internationally while building stronger bilateral relationships, helping open doors for Singaporean businesses. At home he strengthened the competition regime, while creating an environment more friendly to local SMEs and start-ups. Wu Meng also sought to deter unfair business practices and improve consumer protection. He also encouraged the development of commercially viable clean energy solutions, as part of a more sustainable Singapore.

Wu Meng was actively involved in community work for many years before entering politics. Besides focusing on the needs of residents, he has been engaged in reviewing policies in various areas. He most recently sat on the Government Parliamentary Committee (GPC) for Social & Family Development, and earlier served on the GPCs for Health, Home Affairs & Law, and Finance & Trade & Industry.

Wu Meng graduated from the University of Cambridge with a medical degree, as well as a PhD in molecular biology. He is married with two young children.
