- (v) in page 11, lines 8, 9 and 10, by leaving out "is deemed to be hospitalised for a continuous period, beginning immediately after that discharge,";
- (vi) in page 11, lines 12 and 13, by leaving out "that approved hospital", and inserting "a hospital approved by the Minister";
- (vii) in page 11, lines 14 and 15, by leaving out "need to remain hospitalised", and inserting "require hospitalisation";
- (viii) in page 11, line 16, after "rest", by inserting "or further medical treatment";
- (ix) in page 11, line 17, after "recover", by inserting "after his discharge from a hospital";
- (x) in page 12, line 12, after "(7A)";", by inserting "and";
- (xi) in page 12, line 14, by leaving out "; and", and inserting "."; and
- (xii) in page 12, by leaving out lines 15 to 20.
