QUESTIONS FOR ORAL ANSWER

- *1. Mr. Low Yong Nguan: To ask the Minister for Communications whether he is aware of protests from telephone subscribers against the proposed "ten-cent-a-call" system, and if he will give a categorical assurance that the proposed system will not be proceeded with.
- *2. Mr. Low Yong Nguan: To ask the Minister for Education whether existing schools in the vicinity of the present Palembang Housing Estate will be demolished as a result of urban renewal, and whether there are plans to build new schools in the area.
- *3. Tuan Haji Rahmat bin Kenap: To ask the Minister for Social Affairs how many prostitutes were referred to and detained in the approved homes of the Social Welfare Department between 1st July, 1970, and the latest convenient date; for how long are they detained; and what trades are they being taught in such homes.
- *4. Mr. Teong Eng Siong: To ask the Minister for Health if he is considering implementing a 24-hour visit system in children's wards in all Government hospitals, as this would permit parents to assist in looking after their children; and whether it is possible to provide beds for visitors who stay overnight.
- *5. Mr. Low Yong Nguan: To ask the Minister for Health whether an outpatient clinic will be built in the vicinity of the present Palembang Housing Estate.
- *6. Tuan Haji Rahmat bin Kenap: To ask the Minister for Home Affairs how many prostitutes were apprehended between 1st July, 1970, and the latest convenient date; and how many of them were (i) below the age of 21; (ii) Singapore citizens; and (iii) non-citizens.
