Clause 1:

Note:—In page 1, line 5: to leave out “1959” and insert “1960”.

Clause 3:

Minister for Home Affairs:

- (i) **In page 3, lines 22 and 23:** to leave out “contrary to the provisions of subsection (1) of section 7A” and insert “the printing, publication, sale or distribution of which is unlawful under any of the provisions”.
- (ii) **In page 3, line 30:** to leave out “the said” and insert “this”.

Clause 3:

Mr. A. P. Rajah:

- (i) **In page 2, line 14:** to leave out "or incompatible with" and insert "public".
- (ii) **In page 2:** to leave out lines 21 to 23 inclusive.

Note:—In page 2, line 20: to leave out "; or" and insert a full-stop.

Minister for Home Affairs:

- (iii) **In page 2, line 23:** at end, to add—

"(3) Every registration effected in compliance with any order permitting registration shall be notified in the *Gazette*."

(4) Any person aggrieved by a decision of the Registrar under this section may appeal against that decision to the Minister whose decision shall be final."
