SPEAKER TAN CHUAN-JIN REPRESENTS SINGAPORE AT G20 PARLIAMENTARY SPEAKERS' SUMMIT IN JAKARTA, INDONESIA, FROM 5 TO 7 OCTOBER 2022

Speaker of Parliament, Mr Tan Chuan-Jin, is representing Singapore at the 8th G20 Parliamentary Speakers' Summit (P20) in Jakarta from 5 to 7 October 2022, at the invitation of the host country, Indonesia.

- 2 Singapore is a guest country of this P20 hosted by the Indonesian Parliament (see "Background"). During the three-day Summit, he will be meeting and engaging with counterparts and parliamentarians of the G20 nations, as well as representatives of non-G20 countries.
- They will be sharing their legislative experiences and discussing possible strategies for inter-parliamentary cooperation in addressing global issues. In line with this year's theme of "Stronger Parliaments for Sustainable Recovery", they will focus on how parliaments of the world's largest economies can contribute towards sustainable development, food and energy security, effective parliaments, vibrant democracy, social inclusion, and gender equality.
- During the Summit, Mr Tan will be speaking on the topic of "Effective Parliament, Vibrant Democracy" on 6 October. Mr Tan will also hold bilateral meetings with his parliamentary counterparts.

Background

Hosted by the parliament of the country that holds the G20 presidency and with the support of the Inter-Parliamentary Union, the P20 brings together Speakers, Deputy Speakers, and other parliamentarians from the world's 20 major economies. The P20 is part of wider efforts to bring a parliamentary dimension to global governance, aimed at the raising of awareness and building political support for international commitments; and helping to translate these effectively into national realities.
