SPEAKER SEAH KIAN PENG REPRESENTS SINGAPORE AT 11TH G20 PARLIAMENTARY SPEAKERS' SUMMIT (P20) IN KLEINMOND, SOUTH AFRICA, FROM 1 TO 3 OCTOBER 2025

Speaker of Parliament, Mr Seah Kian Peng, is representing Singapore at the 11th G20 Parliamentary Speakers' Summit (P20) in South Africa from 1 to 3 October 2025.

- 2 During the Summit, Speaker will be meeting and engaging with counterparts and parliamentarians of the G20 nations, as well as representatives of non-G20 countries.
- The Summit participants will be sharing their legislative experiences and discussing possible strategies for inter-parliamentary cooperation in addressing global issues. In line with this year's theme of "Harnessing Parliamentary Diplomacy for Realisation of Global Solidarity, Equality and Sustainability", the focus will be on how parliaments serve as essential international platforms for shaping policies, strategies and approaches to address contemporary and emerging challenges and to advance global peace, economic cooperation and sustainable development.
- At the Summit, Speaker Seah will speak during the first and the third working sessions, on the topics of "Strengthening disaster resilience and responses" and "Mobilising finance for a just energy transition" respectively. Speaker Seah will also hold bilateral meetings with his parliamentary counterparts from host nation South Africa and other countries.

Background

Hosted by the parliament of the country that holds the G20 presidency and with the support of the Inter-Parliamentary Union, the P20 brings together Speakers, Deputy Speakers, and other parliamentarians from the world's 20 major economies. The P20 is a part of wider efforts to bring a parliamentary dimension to global governance, aimed at the raising of awareness and building of political support for international commitments, and helping to translate these effectively into national realities.
