- 2 Workplace Fairness Bill "to protect against certain discriminatory behaviour relating to employment and to establish fair employment practices, and to make related amendments to the Employment of Foreign Manpower Act 1990" – presented by the Minister for Manpower; read the first time; to be read a second time on the next available sitting day and to be printed. [Bill No. 50/2024].
- 3 Singapore International Commercial Court (International Committee) Bill read a second time and committed to a Committee of the whole House.

- 11 Government Securities and Treasury Bills (Second Minister for Finance (Mr Chee Hong Tat)) Motion made, and Question put Resolved, "That this Parliament, in accordance with Article 144(1)(a) of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, resolves that a higher amount of One Thousand Five Hundred and Fifteen Billion Singapore Dollars (S\$1,515,000,000,000) be specified for the purposes of section 11(2) of the Government Securities (Debt Market and Investment) Act 1992.".
